





CIRCULAR TOUR TICKET

● Covers three or more consecutive point-to-point journeys, starting from and returning to the same town, which cannot be covered by a through booking at the ordinary return fare.

● Generally 2/- in the £ cheaper than ordinary point-to-point single fares

(except where the circular tour fare would be less than the ordinary return fare between points of a tour by the direct route).

● Valid for up to 3 months for the round trip.

● Break of journey allowed at any station on the route.

● Minimum fares are 40/- Second Class, 60/- First Class.

A Circular Tour ticket can be tailor-made to your own personal requirements. It can start anywhere on British Railways, and the Channel Islands, ports and stations in Northern Ireland can be included.

Book in advance—at least forty-eight hours' notice is needed to enable your ticket to be prepared. The staff at any station or rail ticket agency will be pleased to give you full information and lend their assistance and advice in planning your itinerary for you.
